Andrew Lokan practises in the areas of constitutional law, appellate advocacy, administrative law, labour and employment law, and pension litigation.

Mr. Lokan is an Adjunct Professor at Osgoode Hall Law School, where he teaches Constitutional Litigation. He has also taught law at Ottawa University, and Monash University in Melbourne Australia. He graduated from Ottawa University Faculty of Common Law in 1988, obtained an LL.M. from Harvard University in 1989, and clerked for Madam Justice (now Chief Justice) Beverley McLachlin of the Supreme Court of Canada in 1989-90. Since 1992 he has acted as Special Counsel to the Canadian Civil Liberties Association on a pro bono basis, and he has been a member of the CCLA Board of Directors since 2005. He is a longstanding member of the Ontario Bar Association's Constitutional, Civil Liberties, and Human Rights Section executive. He has appeared in more than 15 cases before the Supreme Court of Canada, and regularly appears before a wide range of other appellate and courts and tribunals, particularly on constitutional law matters. He is co-author of Lokan & Dassios, *Constitutional Litigation in Canada* (Carswell: looseleaf, 2006), and has published widely on subjects relating to public law. He is a frequent speaker on these subjects at seminars and conferences.

Mr. Lokan has been listed since 2009 in *The Best Lawyers in Canada* in the specialty of Administrative and Public Law, and is also listed in *Lawday's Leading Lawyers* in the areas of Charter and Constitutional Law, and Administrative Law.
